

Dear Sh. Ramesh,

I am in receipt of your letter dated 11th January 2014 on the issues of Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) and the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS), the on-going programmes of the Government. This letter apparently has been written in the context of the Model Code of Conduct which will come into force once the Commission announces the schedule for General Election to the Lok Sabha shortly later this year.

I have got the matter examined in the Commission. While the Commission's stand has been that it may not be proper for the Commission to give its advice in such matters before the Model Code comes into force, nevertheless, I thought it fit to give some kind of guidelines in the matter.

1. Generally, on the issue of PMGSY, while the preliminary works relating to the bidding process may continue, the finalization of the bids and the actual implementation of the same cannot be taken up without specific approval of the Commission, if they fall during the period when Model Code is in force.

2. Regarding the MGNREGS, I would like to point out that the points (i) to (iii) raised in para 10 of your letter are already covered and are permissible under the instructions of the Commission conveyed to your Ministry vide our letter No. 437//6/2006-PLN-III (Vol.VIII) dated 16th March 2006 (copy enclosed for ease of reference). As regards, points (iv) and (v) of the said para, these are consequential works to be undertaken for the implementation of the above works and the Commission has no objection in the matter. 

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your D. O letter no 28012/11/05-06-NREGA dated 7th March 2006 on the above mentioned subject and to state that the Commission has reconsidered the matter and decided now as under:-

1. The Ministry of Rural Development shall not increase the number of districts in which NREGA is being implemented after announcement of elections in any State/UT.
2. The job card holders will be provided employment, if they demand work, after announcement of elections in the ongoing works.
3. In case no employment can be provided in ongoing works, the Competent Authority may start new work (s) from the shelf of projects that has been approved and inform the fact to concerned District Election Officer (DEO). No new work shall be started by the Competent Authority till such time employment can be given in ongoing works. In case no shelf of project is available or all works available on shelf have been exhausted then concerned Competent Authority shall make a reference to the Commission for approval through the concerned DEO. The Competent Authority shall also furnish a certificate to DEO to the effect that the new work has been sanctioned as no employment can be given to the job card holder in the on going work. Responsibility for following these instructions shall lie with the Authority sanctioning new work.
4. The Commission's instruction communicated vide its letter of even no. dated 7th February 2006 shall now stand withdrawn.

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

1. This morning you mentioned to me the issue of the election model code of conduct interfering with the award of works under PMGSY.
2. I have had a discussion with Shri V.S. Sampath, Chief Election Commissioner and also followed it up with a detailed letter requesting that for works that have been sanctioned and tendered prior to the commencement of the model code of conduct for the 2014 Lok Sabha elections, relaxation could be given to the state governments to award the works provided, of course, only L-1 is being selected in a transparent manner. He has promised to examine my request and revert back soon.
3. But the other issue that you have raised relates to the model code of conduct for the panchayat elections which are scheduled to begin in early February in Uttarakhand. I discussed this matter as well with Shri Sampath and he told me that this is a matter that must be taken up by you with the State Election Commission.

1. Please refer to the discussions we had on January 10th, 2014.
2. I wish to bring to your personal attention as well as to the attention of the Election Commission some very important issues related to the implementation of the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) and Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) during the period when the Model Code of Conduct would be in force.
3. PMGSY is a flagship programme fully funded by Government of India which provides connectivity to the unconnected habitations in the rural areas of the country. This programme is of special significance in the most backward districts a good number of which are affected by Left Wing Extremism. Detailed Project Reports covering each and every road are vetted by Government of India and approved by a multi-departmental Empowered Committee headed by the Secretary, Rural Development. After this, the States call for competitive bids and after evaluation of the bids, enter into an agreement with the selected bidder on the basis of the L-1 principle. PMGSY-II has also been introduced this year. We reckon that about 8000 road works measuring about 27,000 kms. costing about Rs.15,000 crore are in the process of being tendered/awarded.
4. Analysis of past experience shows that the peak season for construction is from January to May. If we miss the season, there could be delays having a negative cascading effect affecting future programme also. Therefore, I may request the Election Commission to issue the following clarification in regard to PMGSY:-
 - a) All sanctioning and tendering of works have to be completed before the Model Code of Conduct comes into force.
 - b) For tenders received after the Model Code of Conduct has come into force, States may be permitted to accept the tender if it is in order award the contract and start the work without any inauguration or publicity.
 - c) Payment to contractors by way of part bills or final bills may be allowed.
 - d) No tendering/re-tendering need be permitted during the period when the Model Code of Conduct is in force.

5. I understand that Election Commission has upheld the primacy of seasonality while permitting the Ministry of Agriculture to provide the requisite inputs and support during cropping seasons even if the Model Code of Conduct is in force. I would request the Election Commission to adopt this principle for PMGSY as well.

6. As regards MGNREGS, it is not a scheme and it is actually the implementation of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005 which mandates provision of employment on demand including provision of job cards for those without them. Here, the procedure is fixed in the Act and its Schedules and can be summed up as follows:-

(a) The shelf of works to be taken up are prepared through a process starting right from the Gram Sabha upwards through the Panchayati Raj system. This is called the Labour Budget and is normally finalized by Panchayats in January for the next financial year.

(b) The Labour Budget of the districts are aggregated by the State Government and the approval of Government of India is given through discussions in the Empowered Committee headed by the Secretary or the Additional Secretary.

(c) Thereafter, based on the demand, work is provided to the workers - after completing formalities like issue of Administrative Sanctions and Technical Sanctions.

7. In 2006, the Election Commission of India had issued the following clarification:-

"The job card holder will be provided employment, if they demand work, after announcement of elections in the ongoing works. In case no employment can be provided in ongoing works, the competent authority may start new work(s) from the shelf of projects that has been approved and inform the fact to concerned District Election Officer (DEO). No new work shall be started by the competent authority till such time employment can be given in ongoing works. In case no shelf of projects is available or all works available on shelf have been exhausted then concerned competent authority shall make a reference to the Commission for approval through the concerned DEO. The competent authority shall also furnish a certificate to DEO to the effect that the new work has been sanctioned as no employment can be given to the job card holder in the ongoing work. Responsibility for following these instructions shall lie with the Authority sanctioning new work."

8. In 2009, the Election Commission of India had conveyed their 'no objection' to the proposal of Ministry of Rural Development to provide job cards to those applying as it is a continuous process in accordance with the statute.

9. In the case of MGNREGS also, the peak work season would coincide with the likely period of Model Code of Conduct. To give the actual figures of persondays created in 2013:-

March - 22.60 crore

April - 18.31 crore

May - 25.82 crore

10. Therefore, in addition to the clarifications issued earlier, may I request the Election Commission to reiterate the following in regard to MGNREGS:-

(i) All works approved for inclusion in the Labour Budget by the Gram Panchayats, Intermediate Panchayats and District Panchayats before the Model Code of Conduct comes into force, should be deemed to be approved works.

(ii) The works from this approved list may be allowed to be started in accordance with demand.

(iii) No new work need be included.

(iv) Formalities like issue of administrative sanction and technical sanction for works in the Labour Budget approved by Government of India could go on without any publicity.

(v) Materials essentially required for the works, may be allowed to be procured.

11. I request for favourable consideration of both my requests put forward in para 4 and 10 above.

Dear Shri Sampath

1. Please refer to my letter dated January 10th, 2014.
2. In addition, I would like to bring to the notice of the Election Commission another issue regarding the Ministry of Rural Development.
3. We have been conducting the Socio Economic & Caste Census since 2011. This involves covering of every household in rural and urban areas and collecting the data regarding caste and socio-economic status. I am enclosing the relevant document for your reference.
4. Due to several reasons, the conduct of the census has been badly delayed. Now, States have started publishing the draft data to invite claims and objections on the correctness of the data. Though we have advised States to speed this up, it is likely that in the case of several districts, the publication would get pushed to March and April.
5. The publication is only of the data already collected from the households. There is no ordering of the households or indication of any preference or categorization as BPL or APL (a model copy of the draft is enclosed). The intention is only to get the feedback from the households on the correctness of the data entered by the enumerators. Those who find mistakes or omissions can file their objections which would be enquired into following a process.
6. In this context, may I request you to permit publication of SECC data even during the operation of the Model Code of Conduct subject to the condition that the enquiry into the claims and objections may be completed only after the period of Code of Conduct is over.
