Degr Madam

The Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD), Govt. of India has entrusted National Institute of Administrative Research (NIAR) - Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration (LBSNAA), Mussoorie the responsibility of organizing 4 Mahatma Gandhi NREGA State Peer Learning/Orientation Workshops for the year 2012-2013 under the sponsorship of UNDP for DPCs, State Officials and other stakeholders. These workshops are to be conducted (in situ) at the field level for covering all States.

The mandate of the Workshop is to cover issues like – Guidelines for New Works and Framework for "Planning for works and presentation of Labour Budget" and "Work and Execution" Convergence-TSC, RSBY issued by the Ministry and suggestions will also be sought on reforms in the scheme. Apart from the above, other approaches like Financial Inclusion, Social Audit, Mate System & Social Capital Formation etc. with the challenges faced in the field will also be focused upon. Pursuant to that, NIAR, LBSNAA is going to conduct two - days Workshop at Raipur, Chhattisgarh from 7th November, 2012 to 8th November, 2012 for the States - West Bengal, Odisha, Uttar Pradesh, Gujarat, Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, Kerala, Andhra Pradesh and Chhattisgarh. The tentative schedule for the Workshop is enclosed for kind perusal with a request to communicate it to the nominated officials.

The officials who have made any remarkable intervention in the respective District of their jurisdiction to implement MGNREGA will act as resource persons and share their experiences with the participants in the Workshop while giving live demonstration of the practices followed. This will lead to useful learning experiences for the participants.
