

VIDEO CONFERENCE BY ACS P&RD ON 19.5.2016

Action/Decision Points


1. Issue sanction for toilets for all houses listed in 2012 list and not having toilet at present by 31st May 2016. Each district should try to get maximum construction done in the current year itself.
2. Addition/deletion in 2012 survey list is allowed so long as the total number of homes without toilets remains the same. A tap outside the toilet or a wash basin should be insisted for ensuring cleaning of hand, etc.
3. Homes without toilet but not mentioned in 2012 list, be enlisted under the Gramodaya Abhiyan. Sanction for such homes shall be obtained from Government of India after information is available for the entire State.
4. Beneficiaries have freedom of design for construction of toilets so long as sewer or sewer drain water does not come on the public space.
5. There shall be no compulsion for beneficiary to purchase material or get construction done through Panachayat.
6. There are more than 1.80 lakh houses under construction under PM Awas Yojna. Powers have been delegated to CEO, Janpad Panchayat to release instalments in all eligible cases irrespective of the year of construction.
7. Uploading of photos of construction to be done in a campaign mode in next one week. Gramodaya abhiyan nodal officers may be asked to take and upload photos.

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8. Second instalment be released in all eligible cases before 31st May. This is to be counted under Gramodaya Abhiyan.
9. Director, IAY to sort out (a) fund related issue of old cases for Agar Malwa district; and (b) issues relating to entry for enabling issue of FTO for previous years.
10. Extension for time line for verification of SECC list in view of change in eligibility criteria – for the time being the present time line would continue. If time line is to be extended, Director, IAY would issue suitable orders within 3 days.
11. Pendency for 2nd instalment cases is very high in Sidhi, Singrauli and Tikamgarh. Concerned CEO, ZP to personally monitor and resolve.
12. District wise review would be done by ACS in VC of 9th June.
13. Adhar seeding is very poor. Action taken during the Gramodaya Abhiyan has not been commensurate to expectations. Poor Adhar seeding may hinder fund flow and performance under various schemes of the Union Government. CEO, ZP to focus and monitor regularly.
14. Adhar cards not being delivered by post offices to beneficiaries. Director NREGS to meet UDAl officers at State level and resolve.
15. Give top priority to complete all water conservation/storage works. All works which are 50% or more complete be completed before rains.
16. Beneficiary oriented works – about 80,000 works are 50% are more complete and be completed before rains.
17. Keeping in view of fund availability, priority be given to completion of ongoing works. As a thumb rule priority should be as below:
 - a. Completion of works which are 50% + complete;
 - b. Completion of works which are 25% + complete;
 - c. Completion of works which are less than 25% complete; and
 - d. New works.
18. For repair/restoration of water bodies:
 - a. Desilting of water bodies of WRD to be done only after prior written permission from EinC WRD, who would issue case by case permission on receipt of proposal from EE, WRD;
 - b. Desilting of other water bodies – rule of 10H to be strictly adhered to otherwise seepage would take place and tank would become percolation structure.

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- c. Inspection and estimation exercise by RES/WRD engineers as per the directions issued by ACS, WRD to be completed in next one week. Would be reviewed in next VC on 26 May.
19. Problem relating to data entry reported by Dhar for Gramodaya Abhiyan be resolved by Panchayat Darpan officer from Bhopal.
 20. Hat Bazar and rural stadium construction – focus on completion of all sanctioned works in the current year itself.
 21. Commissioner Panchayat to release funds promptly to RES for Hat Bazar and rural stadium.
 22. Letter to collectors for addressing land availability and selection of place be sent from ACS.
 23. CEO, ZP Shivpuri and Datia did not attend VC – advice to go to them for future. In future, those who want exemption from VC to take prior leave of absence.
