2 Stipulated period for completion of services is 12 months including rainy season for each consultancy package.

3 Sale of Bid Documents :

3.1 The Bid documents of the consultancy service packages can be obtained from the office of the E.E. M.P. R.E.S. as mentioned in column 4 upto **5.00 PM of 18th July 2011** on payment of cost of Bid Documents as shown in column no.12 above. The cost of Bid Documents shall be in the form of **Demand Draft only** issued by any scheduled commercial Bank drawn in favour of the **Chief Executive Officer, Madhya Pradesh Rajya Rojgar Guarantee Parishad, Bhopal (M.P.)** payable at Bhopal.

4 Bid documents are also available on website <http://www.nregs-mp.org>. The Bidders are encouraged to download the Bid Document. In case of downloaded Bid Documents, the bidders shall be required to furnish cost of Bid Documents as detailed in paragraph 3.1 above along with submission of Bid Document in a separate fourth envelope in addition to other prescribed envelopes.

5 The bidders are required to furnish an earnest money deposit along with bid in the form of FDR/ DD issued by scheduled commercial bank pledged in favour of **Executive Engineer, Rural Engineering Service, Division as shown in column 4 above.**

6 Last date and time for submission of complete proposal is upto **3:00 PM of 19-07-2011**. Proposals can be submitted in the Office of concerning Superintending Engineer of M.P.R.E.S. or in the Office of Executive Engineer, M.P. R.E.S. as shown in column 4A and 4 respectively above. Technical Proposal will be opened on the same day at 3.30 P.M.

7 Financial Proposal of only such Consultants, whose technical proposal are found responsive, will be opened at **11.30 AM on 22-07-2011** onwards at Meeting hall of Development Commissioner Office, Vindhyachal Bhawan, Bhopal .

8 The bidders may submit proposal for one or more consultancy service package(s) but award of package(s) will be subject to the fulfillment of parameters as mentioned in paragraph 3.1.2 (vii) of Letter of Invitation (LOI). The maximum four consultancy packages shall be awarded during the financial year of the Mukhya Mantri Gram Sadak Yojna Phase-II (2011-12). The consultant already awarded four consultancy packages or upto maximum limit as per para 3.1.2 (vii) of LOI, in NIT No. 7 dated 02.02.2011 of Phase-II shall not be eligible to participate in this NIT.

9 Consultants should submit audited Profit and Loss Account and Balance Sheet with report thereon in support of their receipts as consultancy fee with a certificate of Chartered Accountant to the effect that the receipts relates to consultancy fee for road and bridge construction works only. They shall also submit experience certificate issued by the employer(s).

10 Consultants have to submit an affidavit stating that:

(i) Information, certified copies of the documents supplied with the proposal and under taken given/ certificates attached are true and correct to the best of their knowledge and belief. If any information is subsequently, even after award of consultancy services, is found to be incorrect, MPRES may forfeit their Earnest Money Deposit and debar them from future bidding.

- (ii) Amount of receipts from consultancy fee from road and bridge construction works are correct.
- (iii) Conditions in respect of relatives working as contractors or employees in the Rural Engineering Service in the district(s) included in the bid documents for which proposal is being submitted, are being fulfilled.
- (iv) The bid documents, certified copies of undertakings given and attached certificates etc. have properly been page numbered and indexed
- 11 The procedure to be followed for submission of proposal shall be as per para 4.1.6 of Letter of Invitation (LOI).
- 12 Technical Proposal should be submitted duly page numbered and indexed. All the documents enclosed with the Technical Proposal should be attested by the Consultants. Technical Proposal submitted otherwise will not be considered.
- 13 Balance work of previous year awarded to SQC consultant 2010-11 (Phase-I) on completion of their term or otherwise may also be awarded to consultant of year 2011-12 at the rate which ever is less from rate quoted by previous consultant 2010-11 (Phase-I) and consultant for year 2011-12 (Phase-II).
- 14 The consultant engaged for preparation of DPR and Supervision & Quality Control for works in year 2010-11 (Phase-I) shall only be eligible to submit their bid for the year 2011-12 (Phase-II), who has completed minimum 50% DPR works allotted to them. Bidding consultant has to submit the certificate with technical bid issued by all that/those Executive Engineer of concerned district, where consultant are engaged for preparation of DPR in 2010-11 (Phase-I), stating that 50% DPR works have successfully completed, and those certificate attached with all the technical proposals submitted by consultants.
- 15 Consultants should submit CVs of the Team Leader and the Resident Engineer in the required number as per table-1 given in Para 5.3.1 of the Terms of Reference (TOR) along with the technical proposal. The CVs of TL/RE will be finalised after appropriate screening process including interview etc as prescribed by the employer, interviewing them.
- 16 In order to qualify for award of the work of consultancy services :-
Consultants should have receipts from consultancy fee, as **Prime Consultants**, of not less than Rs. 25.00 lakh from consultancy of road and bridge construction in any one year during the last 3 preceding financial years, and Consultants should as prime Consultants have experience of providing consultancy services for supervision and quality control of road and bridge construction works at least for three preceding years.

or

Consultants/Registered firms/Companies should have minimum 51 percent stake, of the engineer not below the rank of Executive Engineer, retired from the Government service to the State of Madhya Pradesh or Chhattisgarh, and the retired engineer should have at least fifteen years experience in road and bridge construction works.
